- Students who can provide proof of admission in a recognized Canadian institution of learning; OR
- Students completing post-doctorate research in a recognized Canadian institution of learning;

And:

- Are 65 years old or under; and
- Are not eligible for a provincial or territorial government health insurance plan in Canada; and
- Know of no reason to seek medical attention at the time of purchase.

Some of our emergency medical features include:

Covering emergency medical expenses	Up to \$2 million
Covering hospital accommodations	Up to 60 days per sickness or injury
Covering paramedical services	Up to \$500 per profession
Taking care of medical diagnostic tests	Laboratory tests and X-rays
Counselling following a trauma	Up to 6 sessions
Covering psychiatric treatment	Up to \$10,000 when admitted to hospital, and up to \$1,000 for outpatient consultations
